Bandon's Good Earth Community Garden (GE) is a satellite garden of the South Coast Community Garden Association (SCCGA). We are located at the west end of 8th Court SW, off of Franklin. Anyone 18 years or older may apply for SCCGA membership and rent a plot at Good Earth. Plots are rented on a first-come, first-served basis. If all plots are rented when your application is received, you'll be placed on a waitlist.

Fee reductions are available. Contact us for a full or partial fee waiver.

Each person over 18 years of age who gardens at Good Earth Community Garden must become a member of the South Coast Community Garden Association by completing the SCCGA Membership application and paying the annual \$10 **per gardener** SCCGA membership dues.

To participate, please do the following:

1. Complete the Good Earth Community Garden Plot Application below (\$25)
2. Complete the SCCGA Membership Application (\$10 per gardener membership)
3. **Send BOTH applications and a check made out to Good Earth Community Garden for \$35 (or more for additional gardeners, or if you wish to make a donation to Good Earth). Send your two signed applications and check to: Good Earth Community Garden - P.O. Box 1155, Bandon, OR 97411**

Applications will be accepted starting February 1, 2023 and the Garden opens for planting on March 15, 2023. Gardening may begin after that date if completed forms and fees have been received, and new gardeners have attended an orientation. You'll be contacted after receipt of your application.

Gardeners who rented plots in 2022 are not required to participate in an orientation.

The Garden closes on December 1st. **NOTE: Email is the primary way we contact gardeners.**
