- 2. Complete the separate SCCGA Membership Application (\$10 per gardener)
- Send BOTH applications and a check made out to Good Earth Community Garden for \$35 (or more for additional gardeners, or if you wish to make a donation to Good Earth). Send your two signed applications and check to: Good Earth Community Garden - P.O. Box 1155, Bandon, OR 97411

Applications will be accepted as of February 1st and the garden opens for planting on March 15th. Gardening may begin after that date if completed forms and fees have been received, and new gardeners have attended an orientation. You'll be contacted after receipt of your application. The garden closes on December 1st. **NOTE:** Email is the primary way we contact gardeners.
